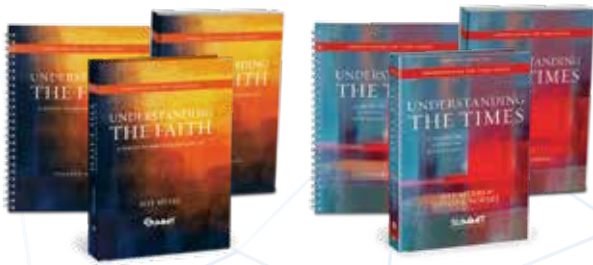




# Earn College Credit FOR WORK YOU'RE ALREADY DOING

High school juniors and seniors can earn college credit for work they are already doing in their *Understanding the Faith* or *Understanding the Times* course.



## 1. How much does it cost?

It only costs \$450 for 3 credit hours (that's \$150 per credit hour). The average cost for a 3-credit college course is \$1,800 for a public school and \$3,600 for a private school. This is a great opportunity to earn college credit at a significant savings.

## 2. How much extra work is required?

College credit scores are based on each student's final exam score. In other words, there are no additional assignments for college credit.

## 3. Will these credits transfer to my school?

Bryan College is a fully accredited private Christian liberal arts college, which means their credits will transfer to 90% of colleges and universities. To be sure, just call the registrar's office of your prospective school to confirm.

## How do I apply?

1. Visit [summit.org/college-credit](http://summit.org/college-credit) to register and pay \$450 tuition by the May 1st deadline.
2. Complete the course with at least a C average.
3. Submit a copy of the final exam before the June 1st deadline.
